

Apple 'Edite'

A disease resistant late apple for regions with cool climate. Cross 'Liberty' x 'Latkrimson'. Breeder's rights: Institute of Horticulture, Latvia, 2009.

Ripening: late midseason (with 'Lobo'), fruits hold very well on the tree.

Storage: 4-5 months common storage.

Fruits: over medium size (70...80 mm), round conical, slightly oblong, smooth.

Skin: firm, bright orange red on at least half of fruit, ground colour yellow.

Flesh: yellow, pink under skin, crisp, juicy, subacid (at picking - acid). Firmness

5.5...7.5 kg/cm², Brix 12...14 %, titrable acid 0.5...0.8 %.

Tree: medium vigour, good frame, some tendency to bare wood. Winter-hardy.

Yield: good to medium, regular, fruits self-thinning.

Flowering time: medium.

Resistance: resistant to scab (Vf/Rvi6), tolerant to other diseases (mildew, fruit rot,

Nectria canker).

Positive traits: Complex disease resistance; winterhardiness; bright, smooth fruits; regular production, fruits self-thinning.

Drawbacks: May be too acid at harvest; skin scald for late-harvested fruits.
