

Apple 'Roberts'

A disease resistant early apple with very attractive fruits.

Cross: BM414967 x 'Eksotika'. Breeder's rights: Institute of Horticulture, Latvia, 2009.

Ripening: early, 0-7 days after 'Discovery'. Needs several pickings. Storage about 2 months.

Fruits large to very large, oblong conical or elliptic, very attractive. Skin firm, with dark red over-colour to 100% and strong bloom. Flesh yellowish, pink under skin, medium firm, crisp and juicy, subacid, aromatic, flavour good.

Tree medium vigour, upright-spreading, branching is rather low. Production early and good. Tends to yield biennially.

Flowering medium late.

Resistances: high resistance to scab (Vf/Rvi6), medium to mildew, fruit rot and *Phyllosticta* leaf spot. High winter-hardiness.

Recommended rootstocks and training: dwarfing (M9, B9 etc.). Horizontal training of branches is recommended to increase productivity, along with heading back of shoots for better branching.
