

Apple 'Inta'

A midseason apple with very good fruit quality, productive tree easy in training, and relatively good tolerance to diseases. Fruits hold well on tree and have a long harvest window, have bright colour and very crisp, juicy flesh.

Obtained in Dobele, Institute of Horticulture, as open pollinated seedling of 'Yellowspur Golden Delicious' in 1997. Cultivar application: 2016 (LV Nr.16005). Breeder's rights: Institute oh Horticulture, Latvia.

Ripening: medium. Hold well on tree, recommended to pick as possibly late to obtain more intense over-colour.

Storage (common storage at 2...3°C): 3...4 months or longer. No storage diseases observed. Good also with 1-MCP storage.

Fruits: attractive, over medium size or large. Bright, uniform, dark red overcolour and yellow or greenish yellow ground colour. Fruit shape globose, with medium, smooth ribbing. Fruit skin medium thick, firm, flesh medium firm -4.6...5.3kg cm⁻², tolerant to bruises.

Flesh: yellowish, very crisp and juicy, subacid with dominance of sweetness. Very good taste panel evaluation. Contains 12.3...13.0 °Brix, 0.46...0.6% acids. High sugar-acid proportion – 21.7...26.7. Rather high total polyphenol content – 93...141 mg 100 g⁻¹, which increases the nutritive value.

Tree: medium vigour, easy in training, with naturally wide branching angles, medium dense. Some crown thinning is recommended to improve fruit colour. Productive, with a tendency to bienniality.

Flowering time: medium, flower buds purple red.

Tolerance to diseases: good, relatively tolerant to scab, tolerant to other diseases – mildew, fruit rots. No canker injury observed so far.

Winter-hardiness: good.
