

‘Ina’



High yielding cultivar with very big fruits Cross of ‘Ivanovskaja’ x ‘Taganka’. Registered in Latvia in 2004.

Winterhardiness : average

Bush: medium height and medium sparse. Creates relatively few root suckers (primocanes). The spines are located all over the cane, but more are in the lower part of the cane.

Fruits: Ripening time medium early. Fruits are large, stretched conical, red. Weight of fruits 4.5-5 g, but growing in irrigated areas up to 8 g. The pulp is dense, the drupelets are relatively large, tightly connected. Good, sweet-sour taste.

Yield is good – 2.6-3 kg per rows meter. Average yield is 8.7-10 t ha⁻¹ at a planting distance of 0.5 x 3 m.

Resistance to diseases: satisfactory to raspberry spur blight, good to raspberry cane blight .
