## 'Rita'



The cultivar is originated from gooseberry hybrids of A.Vīksne.

Winterhardiness: good.

Bush medium high. Branches vigorous, drooping. There are practically no thorns on the shoots. The berries ripening time is late. Berries large, dark red, oval. The taste is pleasantly sweet-sour.

Yield good. Although yield is less than the cultivar 'Lepaan Punainen', the berries are larger and berry picking is much easier.

Resistance to diseases: very good to American powdery mildew of gooseberry, good to leaf spot .
