

‘Viktorija’



Cultivar with large fruits. Cross of ‘Ivanovskaja’ x M150. Registered in Latvia in 2011.

Winterhardiness: average.

Bush medium high. Canes purple-brown, upright with slightly drooping tops. The spines are located throughout the cane.

Fruits red, large, trapezoidal. Time of fruit ripening a little bit later like ‘Ina’. The flesh is dense and the drupelets are tightly fastened to each other.

The taste is sweet-sour, without a pronounced flavor, but better than ‘Glen Ample’. Yield good.

The cultivar is moisture demanding. Lack of water significantly reduces the size of the berries.

Resistance to diseases : satisfactory to raspberry spur blight and cane blight.
